**Treaty Land Entitlement claims are intended to settle the land debt owed to those First Nations who did not receive all the land they were entitled to under historical treaties signed by the Crown and First Nations. Settlement agreements are negotiated among First Nations, the Government of Canada and the province. A specified amount of Crown lands is identified and/or a cash settlement is provided so that a First Nation may purchase federal, provincial, or private land to settle the land debt. Once selected or purchased, this land can be added to the First Nations' reserve.**
