Background

Dovetail Consulting Inc. has been retained on contract by the Oil and Gas Commission (OGC), on behalf of the Science and Community Knowledge (SCEK) Fund, to assist with a review of the Consultation Process Agreements (CPAs) that have been established between the Government of British Columbia and six participating Treaty 8 First Nations. The review is to be undertaken on behalf of the Implementation Committee (IC), which is responsible for oversight of the CPAs.

The review will examine:

- The efficiency and effectiveness of the implementation progress;
- The parties' satisfaction with the agreement;
- Improvements to the relationships; and
- Progress towards implementing the agreement and recommendations for further implementation guidance.

The review project began in early January and will be completed by May 2010.

Community Coordinator Position

The Community Coordinator will play a pivotal role in ensuring that SFN can participate effectively in the CPA review. The Community Coordinator will work under the supervision of the Saulteau First Nations and in close cooperation with the Dovetail team.

Candidates for this position in each community should have the following qualities, skills and experience:

- Commitment to the objectives of the CPA review process and a willingness to cooperate with First Nations staff and the consulting team;
- Familiarity with the interests of the Saulteau First Nations and with oil and gas-related activities within the territory;
- Ability to conduct outreach with community members and to encourage their involvement with the CPA review;
- Strong reading and writing skills;
- Good listener;
- Computer skills: ability to use Microsoft word and the Internet;
- Past experience in conducting semi-structured surveys and interviews within the community.

It is anticipated that an orientation and training session for Community Coordinators and Land Managers from each community will be held in Fort St. John on February 11, 2010.
